SCHEDULE 1 - SPECIFICATION

Introduction to the NRF

The National Research Foundation ("NRF") is a juristic person established in terms of the National Research Foundation Act, Act 23 of 1998, and a Schedule 3A Public Entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act. The NRF is the government's national agency responsible for promoting and supporting research and human capital development through funding researchers, provision of the National Research Platforms, and science outreach platforms/programs to the broader community. The NRF provides these services in all fields of science and technology, including natural science, engineering, social science, and humanities. The NRF delivers its mandate through its internal business units which are both functional and geographical diverse. All contracts flowing from bidding only apply to iThemba LABS (Cape Town).

Evaluation Process

PHASE 1 – EVALUATION IN TERMS OF THE STIPULATED MINIMUM

The local content (LC) expressed as a percentage of the bid price must be calculated in accordance with the following formula:

Only locally produced or locally manufactured clothing with the stipulated minimum threshold of 100% for local production and content requirements for clothing will be considered and only bids meeting this requirement will qualify for the Phase 2 evaluation.

In cases where raw materials are not available locally: if the raw material or input for the office Textile, Clothing, Leather and Footwear is not available locally, bidders should obtain written authorization from the DTI should there be a need to import such raw material or input. A copy of the authorization letter must be submitted together with the bid at the closing date and time of the bid invitation.

PHASE 2 - PREFERENTIAL POINT SYSTEM SCORING

Bids must comply with the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content in phase 1 to proceed to phase 2 of the evaluation.

Applicants meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content requirements, will then be scored on the 80/20 principle, based on their price and B-BBEE ratings respectively.

The applicant with the highest total number of points will be awarded the contract.
